## Sample Financial Guarantee and Parental Support Letters

Please refer to the **samples below as guides** on the types of letters required for the financial guarantee. These are samples only. You should contact your financial institution or sponsors about preparing letters using the type of formats shown below. It is very important that the amount that you are required to show be specifically stated within the letter. Simply having a bank write that you or your parents have sufficient funds will not be accepted unless the designated amount is mentioned or unless the amount of savings is clearly shown.

Sample #1 – account is in student's name

Sample #2 – account is in the parent's/guardian's name. This must be accompanied by a parental support letter.

Sample #3 – Institutional guarantee – the institution's letter must include the following information  Date:
